PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Congratulations are in order to all our members. The annual TREDDA fundraiser generated a net profit of approximately \$7,000, thanks to you. Your participation and donations from sponsors continue to generate more funds for our treasury. The fundraising committee, chaired by Karen Hawkins and Teresa Garces, the raffle committee, chaired by Dianna Buxkemper, did an outstanding job in coordinating all facets of the event. The other team members helped us make another successful event. Corporate sponsors are mentioned elsewhere in this newsletter. We also thank our sister organization, the San Antonio Area Retired Teachers Association for publicity in their newsletter and ticket sales at their meeting. The board appreciates the trust which you have given to us in carrying forward our goal of enhancing the quality of life of retirees in financial need. TREDDA membership is comprised of many outstanding leaders in the field of education. Seven members have namesake public school campuses located in Bexar County. We recognize them in a series of mini-biographies beginning with this issue.

Our awardees continue to face daunting challenges from many fronts. TRS pension amounts are virtually frozen until the pension fund balance approaches a more actuarially sound amount. Retirees who chose the regular TRS-care option face increased annual deductibles and higher co-payments beginning January, 2017. Future retirees will face challenges from opponents to the current defined benefits pension versus a defined contribution plan. The defined contribution pension plan places more of the stock market investment risk on the retiree. Most of us do not have the knowledge or time to follow and understand the fluctuations and trends in stock market prices. You either sink or swim on your own or hire an investment counselor for advice. Tim Lee of TRTA provides current updates on this challenge to public school retirees.

WINN MURNIN: Dr. Winn Murnin Elementary School, Northside ISD

Dr. Winn Murnin graduated from Thomas More College at eighteen years of age! Winn began a 24 year career at Northside in 1970 as a high school math teacher. She then worked in school administration as assistant principal, principal at Stevenson Middle School, director of Secondary Education, and Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction.

Throughout her professional career Winn set high expectations for both students and staff. Her peer attest to Winn's putting students and staff first, and that she promoted a climate of cooperation, humor, and respect. She was innovative in developing pupil-friendly programs; Academic Fair, Independent Study Mentorship, and EXCEL math program for secondary schools.

Since "retiring" Dr. Murnin has worked as Director of Student Teaching at UTSA, operated an estate sales business, and served on the boards of several community groups. When asked to name her greatest achievement, Winn answered that her proudest achievement is her family; the raising of five children and seven stepchildren.

BOBBYE BEHLAU: Bobbye Behlau Elementary School, Northside ISD

Bobbye Behlau is known and recognized for her love of history and education. She began her formal education in a one-room school in Texas. After graduating from Abilene Christian College, she taught in elementary schools in three different states. Her husband's military assignments demanded frequent relocations. They settled in Texas in 1962, when she began teaching first graders at NSISD. In 1972, Bobbye was promoted to reading specialist for five schools. In 1979, she began a career in school administration, retiring as principal of Timberwilde Elementary School in 1989.

The key factors to Bobbye's success as an educator included her efforts to increase parent involvement and commitment to her students' education and literacy. Fellow teacher comments regarding her leadership skills include admiration for her work ethic, dedication to staff, and the development of the Trailblazer Citizenship Program for children. After retirement, Bobbye has written a history of Northside ISD, co-founded its School Museum group, and helped start a retiree newsletter and the annual retiree luncheon. She supervised student teachers at Texas State and taught reading courses a NEISD Community Ed. Now living in Lampasas, Bobbye serves on the board of Preserve Lampasas and writes a monthly column of the local newspaper. *source: Northside ISD website*
