President's Message

These are exciting times for Texas educators. The Texas Legislature meets again this oddnumbered year. Three issues vitally important to educators are on the front-burner: increased funding for public education, increased pay for teachers, and remedying the dire financial status of TRS-Care. The governor is optimistic and has publically endorsed support for increases, but now the legislators must find monies to address current and future needs. Previous legislatures approved stop-gap measures, but failed to consider our population growth, infrastructure needs, and maintenance, etc. Visit the TRS website for additional information and details.

Unfortunately, pension increases for TRS retirees do not appear to be feasible for now. TRS cannot offer a permanent increase until its fund balance exceeds an actuarial threshold. Texas Retired Teachers Association is recommending major changes in the contribution rates from the state and active employees as a means to increase reserves. The sad facts are the following:

- Thirty percent of TRS retirees (130,000) receive \$1,000 per month or less.
- Ninety five percent of public school employees are not covered by Social Security and the TRS pension is the main source of income. (Source: TRTA The Voice, 2019)

At this time your TREDDA board is increasing its advertising budget to inform TRS retirees of the availability of financial assistance from us. We understand from past experience that many retirees are reluctant to ask for help with the hope that their situation will improve. Many Bexar County retirees need our help. Our annual fundraiser was extremely successful, thanks to our members, TREDDA board members, and sponsors. We netted \$9,000.
